After School Spanish Sessions at Burnopfield Primary School

Come and have fun learning Spanish!

Here at Lingotot, we are very excited to be continuing our award-winning language sessions at Burnopfield Primary School in the Summer term.

Lingotot classes allow your child to develop new communication skills and build a vocabulary in a new language. Research has shown that learning a second language at an early age can improve children's academic ability and social development. Lingotot makes language learning fun through play, song and storytelling. Following our carefully tried and tested methodology, your child could leave the very first class responding to the Spanish they hear.

After school sessions start back on Thursday 2nd May for Reception, Years 1 and 2. The classes run from 3.20pm until 4.20pm on Thursdays and continue each week during term time for 10 weeks.
