Please see attached information regarding a Grassroots basketball event that is coming up. Please return slips and money to school if interested. Thank you.



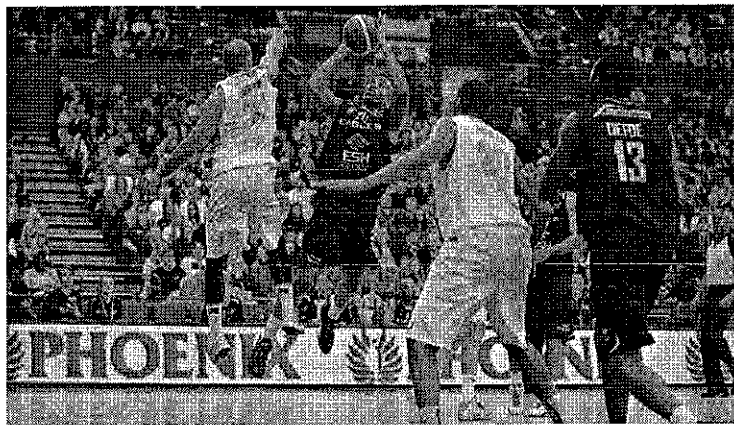
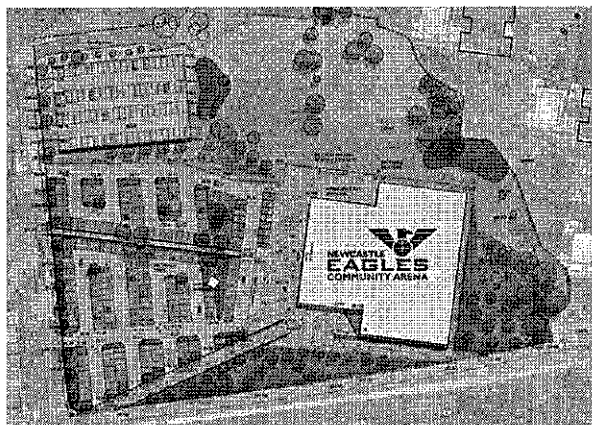
