At Burnopfield Primary we are committed to ensuring our children leave our school with a wide breadth of experience and knowledge about a range of different artistic styles and cultures. We recognise the importance of not only developing our children's own skills in Art but also giving them experiences and opportunities to work with and observe professionals.

Throughout the Foundation Stage our children are given opportunities to develop their ideas and practice controlling their skills when painting, drawing or using clay. The children also experience outdoor Art work and make their own collages. The children are always able to access Art materials in the Foundation Stage in order to develop a personal enjoyment for the subject. Our Nursery children get to experience work with a Cartoon Artist and our Reception children get to experience work with an Observational Artist, so by the time our children leave Foundation Stage they have had valuable experiences of different styles of Art and working with professionals.

Throughout Key Stages 1 & 2 our children study a new Artist each term, giving them the inspiration and knowledge about the subject. Our Art curriculum includes Famous Artists, Local Artists and Art from different cultures so that our children leave our school with a wide breadth of experience and knowledge about a range of different artistic styles and cultures.

Children will appreciate that anyone can become an Artist.	Children will study a range of local Artists throughout their time at school. The children will also experience visits to galleries and invite professional Artists into school for inspirational workshops.	Children will be inspired by working with professionals and may aspire to achieve their own artistic goals.
Children will develop their Cultural Capital and learn about Art from other Cultures.	Children will study a range of Art from other cultures throughout their time in school. Children will be able to make comparisons between different styles of Art work and take inspiration from whichever they like most.	Children will learn about Art from other Cultures and leave our school with a higher amount of Cultural Capital.
Children will develop their own Artistic style.	Children will study a wide range of Artists including Local, Art from other cultures and Classic Famous Artists. Children will be taught about making comments and comparisons about Art work using the correct language.
